Solon Jewish Preschool Pandemic Protocols

Solon Jewish Preschool adheres to all mandatory requirements from the CDC & Day Care licensing as well as many of the suggested practices. Following these rules can mitigate the risks but it does not eliminate the risk of COVID-19.

Drop Off/Pick Up

 All drop off and pick up will be done curbside. Parents are asked not to enter the building unless absolutely necessary.

Illness

- We will be taking the temperature of every staff & worker before they enter the building with a Non Contact Thermometer. Students will be asked to remain in their car until their temperature is taken. Anyone that has a temperature of 100 or more will be asked to go home and not return until they are fever free for 24 - 48* hours.
- If a child or teacher tests positive for COVID19, that class will be closed for the next 14 days and they will have classes on Zoom. Reimbursement policy applies
- If a child or staff has close contact to someone that tests positive for Covid-19, then they will need to quarantine for 14 days.

Distancing:

- Each class will be assigned their own bathroom and handwashing sink, as well as a designated space outside. They will spend time outside as much as possible, weather permitting.
- We will offer Specials like Dance & Karate, but specialists will be a minimum of 10 feet away from children at all times.
- Each child will have his/her own assigned seat, yoga mats, supply box of markers, scissors, sensory bins and are asked NOT to bring any toys from home.

Masks

 Staff & all adults are required to wear masks and parents decide their preference for preschoolers.

Sanitization

 We hired an extra cleaner who will be constantly sanitizing bathrooms, playground and other high touch areas, such as door knobs throughout the day.

Food

- Preschool will provide prepackaged snacks & fruits only and staff will use gloves and masks when distributing.
- Students are asked to bring their own lunch and all containers should be easy for them to open without too much assistance. (Please note that our facility is peanut free, and if you send a meat lunch, make sure that it is Kosher.)

Hand Washing

Staff and children must follow rigorous handwashing procedures as detailed by Ohio Law.

- Arrival of the day
- After using the restroom
- After outdoor play
- When visibly soiled
- Prior to departure
- Before eating and after eating
